


Submissions, Editorial Outcomes and Published Counts

Accepted



Submitted Articles by Continent (Submission Date)





Median Submission To Editorial Outcome Days


Median Submission To First Publication Online Days

Mentored Reviews


- Annals of Epidemiology encourages mentored reviews

 - Optional questions designed for more advanced students






